HOW TO GET TO HALIFAX

Halifax is readily accessible by road, rail from Montréal, and air to the Halifax International Airport. There is a shuttle service from the airport to the Lord Nelson Hotel.

The Lord Nelson Hotel is situated in the heart of Halifax and is within reach of various attractions such as the Citadel, the Halifax Public Gardens, shopping and restaurants.
